The Sir Robert Jennings Professor of International Law, University of Leicester

Malcolm Shaw QC is the Sir Robert Jennings Professor of International Law at the University of Leicester. Before that he was at the University of Essex, where he was the Founder-Director of the Human Rights Centre in 1983. He is the author of 'International Law' (6th edition, 2008) published by Cambridge University Press and translated into Polish, Hungarian, Chinese and Portuguese and 'Title to Territory in Africa' (1986) published by Oxford University Press. He has edited a number of books and had articles published in leading periodicals such as the British Year Book of International Law and the International and Comparative Law Quarterly. He is a Member of the Advisory Council of the British Institute of International and Comparative Law and of the Editorial Committee of the British Year Book of International Law. He is also a practising barrister at Essex Court Chambers and has represented Governments and private clients in a wide range of international law cases, appearing before the International Court of Justice, the European Court of Human Rights and English courts.
